Background:

Ballinora Camogie Club wants to share the achievements and successes of its players and teams with the world! We need some help in making sure all of the key information makes it onto our website and into our other channels of communication. Building on the best practice used by the Junvenile GAA Club, where each coordinator assigns a PR Champion to work with coordinators throughout the year, we've created a framework that we think will give more flexibility to those involved, as well as allow for the responsibility to be shared.

Responsibility:

- Take (or ensure someone else takes) at least 3 photos at or during the match.
- Send photos, final score of match and brief update/summary to PRO by the evening after the match (*for example, Sunday match result is sent to PRO by Monday evening latest*).

Practicalities:

While each team can operate in a way that suits those involved, we suggest that a trainer or mentor assigns each player a match, either in advance (schedule permitting) or on a match by match basis, whichever is more appropriate. That player, or the parent of the player if the player is aged U12, is responsible for completing the tasks outlined above. If a player or her parent is unable to complete the tasks, it is the responsibility of the player, or the player's parents if U12, to ask someone else to take on the role of Player/Parent Reporter for the match. It is envisioned that the role would be rotated, so no Player/Parent has the responsibility all year.
